In Language Arts this week, our focus was on identifying elements of persuasive articles and on using text evidence to determine the author's point of view on a given topic. In Grammar, our focus was on using irregular past tense verbs correctly in writing. Students also continued writing their narrative stories with their partners this week.

In Math, we continued our Module 4 Geometry Unit this week. At the beginning of the week, students explored lines of symmetry in a variety of figures. Students then practiced classifying triangles by angle measures and side lengths. Lastly, students worked on identifying and drawing special attributes of specific quadrilaterals.

In Science, we had another visit from the Roger Williams Zoomobile. During this hands-on exploration, the focus was on identifying characteristics used in animal classification. Students also began researching and taking notes on their chosen animal for their "10 Things I Know" project. At the end of the week, students took a Plant Parts quiz. In Social Studies, students took a quiz on our country's economy and regions.
