In Language Arts this week, our focus was on summarizing the main idea of biographical information and identifying an author's point of view on a topic. Additionally, students practiced using text features of biographies and context clues to determine the meaning of unfamiliar words and concepts. In Grammar, students continued identifying and using linking verbs properly in writing.

In Math, we continued our Engage NY Module 4 Geometry Unit. Students practiced identifying right, obtuse, and acute angles in various figures. Students also practiced identifying and drawing perpendicular and parallel lines using a ruler and right angle template. Lastly, students used a protractor to measure the angle measurement of various right, acute, and obtuse angles.

In Social Studies, we continued preparing for our country's government quiz that was given Thursday, January 23rd.

In Science, we continued examining how various plants and animals use a variety of internal and external structures to survive and thrive in their environments.
